

**Standard Operating Procedure**

All emergency battery lights will be maintained in accordance with the manufacturer's specifications and recommendations and per N.F.P.A.

**Purpose**

To ensure cleanliness and proper operations.

**Procedure**

Monthly:

1. Clean.
2. Tighten connections as needed.
3. Fill batteries as needed.
4. Take hydrometer reading as required.
5. Test operation. Thirty seconds once per month 90 minutes once per year.
