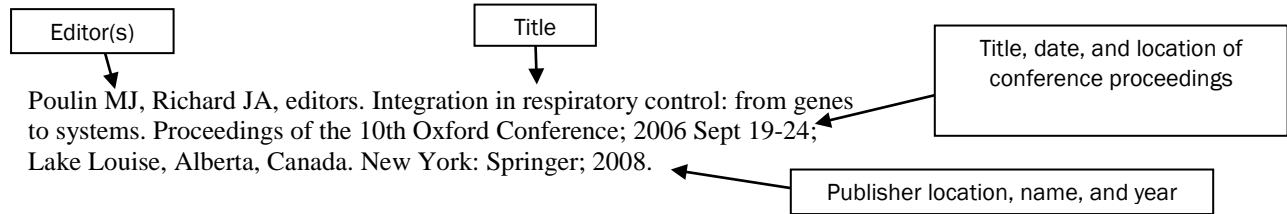
Part of a Book (Chapter, Paper)



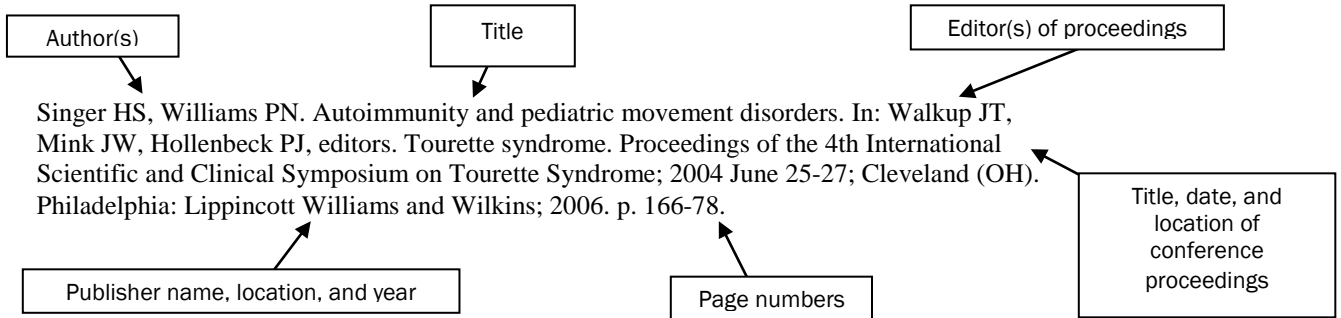

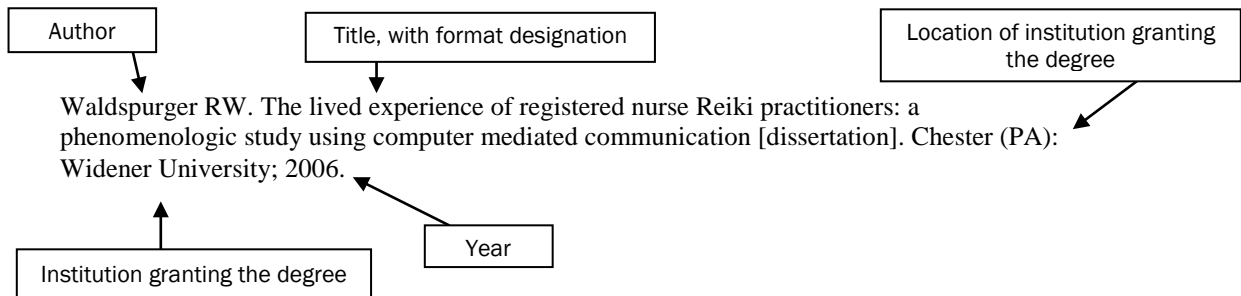
